

DROP YOUR DEFENSIBLE SPACE SLASH FOR FREE

This all-volunteer program is a cooperative effort of the Shingletown Council Inc., Shasta County, & Waste Management. Funding for these programs is provided by the California Department of Forestry & Fire Protection as part of the California Climate Investment Program.

DETAILS

Dates: Tuesday **May 4** and Saturday **May 8, 2021** Times: **9:00 a.m. through 3:00 p.m.**

Location: Shingletown Transfer Station, Highway 44 at Ritts Mill Rd. – Follow the signs once inside

Cost: *** **FREE** *** (donations will be gratefully accepted) – all donations are used to support our programs)

RULES

1. Only slash pile debris such as brush, tree limbs, & yard raking can be accepted – ***KEEP YOUR NEEDLES & LIMBS SEPERATED PLEASE!!***
2. **NO** stumps nor logs larger than 20” can be accepted (Shasta air quality rules & equipment limitations)
3. Absolutely **NO** lumber, construction debris, trash, poison oak, or garbage will be accepted – your load will be inspected before your unloading & you will be asked to remove unacceptable items and take them home.
4. Please don’t enter the trash dumping area – follow the “brush” sign to our drop point
5. For your safety, please follow the guidance of the drop site volunteers at all times Do not go to the transfer station area with slash. Volunteers will help you unload your piles, but it speeds things up if debris is on a tarp in your vehicle/trailer – use the **Shinglebilly Rapid Trailer Unloader Thingy** diagram (email us if you need a copy)
